

SNAKE DAY

15 OCTOBER 1994

As a member of the Society you and your family have free admission by presenting the ticket which is printed on the enclosed program. Non-members have to pay an entrance fee of Hfl. 5.

During the Snake Day you have the opportunity to buy back volumes, stickers, posters etc or to ask information at the Society stand. It is also possible to renew your membership or to become a member of the Society.

Coffee, tea, soft drinks, breadrolls are available in the canteen.

There will be stands with reptile dealers, terrarium equipment, books, prey animals etc. Other societies will also be represented.

It is possible to sell or buy snakes during the Snake Day, but some rules should be observed:

- It is forbidden to bring any native Dutch species. These are: Coronella austriaca, Natrix natrix, Vipera berus.
- Handle the snakes as little as possible.
- It is <u>not</u> allowed to bring animals other than snakes or prey animals such as mice and rats.
- Venomous snakes are only allowed in the special venomous snake section of the building.
- Venomous snakes have to be carried individually in solid, transparent or partly transparent boxes which are properly locked. The boxes should pose no danger for escapes or bites. The boxes are not to be opened during the Snake Day and if you have a number of boxes you should use a bag or large box in which you put the separate boxes to transport them. Write the scientific name of the snake on the box.

We would like to stress that documents are often required for the import or export of snakes. In case of the CITES list, you should have all the documents required with you.

Smoking is not allowed, nor is the use of alcoholic drinks. The European Snake Society is not responsible for any kind of loss, damage or injury incurred during the Snake Day. We count on your kind cooperation and we hope that you will have an interesting Snake Day again this year.

The University campus can be reached with busses nr. 11 or 12 from the city center.
