# ANNUAL REPORT OF THE SOCIETY

From our secretary

Last year brought at least one remarkable change: the layout of the magazine Litteratura Serpentium has been changed completely. This change was meant to make the magazine more readable by giving it a more modern look. According to the board of the European Snake Society the editors did do very well by making this choice.

Another change has been made by using Internet. Though the European Snake Society had its own homepage already for some time (http://www.worldaccess.nl/ess), it seemed wise to increase possibilities to contact the members of the board. Especially for future members that do not live in The Netherlands Internet, and in particular e-mail, offer great opportunities to contact the board in a rather cheap way. Therefor the secretary (ess@worldaccess.nl) and the treasurer (treas@worldaccess.nl) have their an Internet subscription and the means to send and receive e-mail. Till now Internet is well used by people all over the world who like to know something more about our society and snakes in general. Every week the society receives about five e-mails. We expect that this number will increase because of the increasing private use of Internet all over the world.

For the first time in history the Snake Day 1996 did not show an increase in the number of visitors. Just as in 1995, in 1996 about 3.000 people came to Houten to visit the Snake Day. That the number of visitors did not increase may be due to the Salamandra Tagung, which took place in Germany on the same date as the Snake Day. However, the board is very satisfied about the Snake Day 1996. The quality of the lectures was high. The board wishes to express its appreciation to everyone who delivered a lecture or helped in some other way to make the Snake Day 1996 so successful.

The number of members is slowly increasing. Currently there are about 860 members, about half of them Dutch. In view of the fact that the European Snake Society wishes to be an international society, it would be nice to increase the percentage of members living outside Holland.

The board wishes that the 17th society year will as successful as last year and that you will enjoy being member of the European Snake Society. One of the highlights will be undoubtedly the Snake Day, which will be held on October 25th in Houten.
